CLASS DESCRIPTION:	Introduction to various concepts and classifications of costs. Job order and process costing. Analysis of cost behavior, particularly that of mixed costs.
CLASS OBJECTIVES:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. To understand the various concepts and classifications of costs.2. To become familiar with different kinds of costing systems designs, including job order costing and process costing.3. To develop an understanding of cost behavior patterns.
CLASS FORMAT OVERVIEW:	The material will be presented in a lecture-discussion format, and students should be prepared to present solutions to the assigned exercises and problems at the end of each chapter.
REQUIREMENTS:	Time spent in preparation for or reflection on course lecture will approximate two hours outside of class for each lecture credit hour utilized by the instructor in delivery of the material and ¼ hour outside of class for each hour of structured lab time.
TESTING:	The tests in this class are open-book. Therefore it is mandatory that students attend and prepare for class each day. The grade for each module will be based 80% on the average of the tests taken that module and
