Superscript note explanations:

- 1 Legal Research & Writing (OCT) begins 10/8/18-ends 12/10/18; Introduction to Law (OCT) begins 10/9/18 - ends 12/11/18.
- 2 Law Study & Exams - session starts 10/4/18 and ends 12/13/18, then restarts 1/10/19 and ends 2/7/19.
