

CLASS NUMBER AND NAME: **ACN185—PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION PREPARATION**

CLASS DESCRIPTION: This class utilizes practice tests for preparation for the Certified Bookkeeper designation. NBA, National Bookkeepers Association, testing is included in this class.

CLASS OBJECTIVES: The student will review the concepts and techniques learned in Accounting Fundamentals in order to pass the NBA bookkeeping certification test.

CLASS FORMAT OVERVIEW: This class is a lab. Lab time is spent using practice tests to prepare for the certification test.

REQUIREMENTS: Students are required to maintain a minimum of 80 percent attendance and complete tests on a regular basis. After the practice tests are completed at the 80 percent accuracy level and the student has a thorough understanding of the exam objectives, the student will be qualified to take the exam for certification.

Time spent in preparation for or reflection on course lecture will approximate two hours outside of class for each lecture credit hour utilized by the instructor in delivery of the material and ¼ hour outside of class for each hour of structured lab time.

TESTING:

The final for this class will be the NBA bookkeeping certification test administered in a proctored classroom setting.

GRADING POLICIES:

Grades will be based on completing all assignments on the class schedule on time.

FINAL GRADE:

This is a Pass or Fail class. To pass the class the student must complete all assignments on time as listed on the schedule with 80% or better attendance.

No Incomplete grades will be issued for this course.

ANTICIPATED LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Upon completing this class, the student will:

1. Have practiced accounting concepts utilizing textbook tests to review the concepts learned in the accounting fundamentals classes.
2. Utilize Connect software and the College Accounting textbook to complete the practice tests with 80 percent accuracy or better before attempting and obtaining certification.
3. Complete the NBA bookkeeper certification test with 80 percent accuracy.
