**PREREQUISITES:**

Completion of GBN132C or enrollment in the Tourism, Hospitality, and Wine Industries program

**TEXT AND MATERIALS:**

Career Portfolio  
ProQuest eLibrary

**CLASS DESCRIPTION:**

Students will create a professional career portfolio as a visual representation of their education, experience, strengths, abilities, skills, accomplishments, and work for employment interviews.

**CLASS OBJECTIVES:**

Students will be able to demonstrate their researching capabilities on the Internet, use of the e-library, related to job opportunities in their career field and learn how to use their career portfolio in an interview..

**CLASS FORMAT OVERVIEW:**

This course will be a combination of lab work with consultation with the project director (instructor).

**REQUIREMENTS:**

Time spent in preparation for or reflection on course lecture will approximate two hours outside of class for each lecture credit hour utilized by the instructor in delivery of the material and ¼ hour outside of class for each hour of structured lab time.

**METHODS OF INSTRUCTION:**

This is a lab class with instructor supervision. Lab time is spent completing assignments using the Internet and e-library.

The course requirement is to produce a complete employment portfolio and small business development plan using the guidelines provided by the instructor.

**ATTENDANCE:**

It is critical to the student's success to attend class every day. Students must maintain 80 percent attendance.

**TESTING:**

No tests will be given.

**GRADING POLICY:**

The grade for the project will be determined by the following criteria:

- Class assignments and presentations 50 percent
- Final presentation of project 50 percent

The final grade for this project will be awarded according to the following evaluation points:

The final grade will be the average of all work submitted by the end of the term.
