 - Was the property "of another"?
 - Legal v. factual impossibility?
 - Could this be an attempted larceny?

1. Larceny-Sam's cell phone
 - Did she have the intent to permanently deprive at the time of the taking?
 - Was this evidenced by her lie "that he must have lost it."?
 - Was this evidenced by her throwing it into a lake to get rid of it?
2. Burglary- Tina's house
 - What is the felony therein? Murder/manslaughter??
3. Malicious mischief-smashing of the window with bullet and shattering the cookie jar with bullet
4. Unlawful homicide of Tina
 - Felony Murder?
 - Discuss Ireland Doctrine/merger/bootstrapping application
 - Murder or voluntary manslaughter (Heat of passion)?
5. Attempted Murder/voluntary manslaughter of Sam
 - Intent to kill (express malice vs. manslaughter?)
 - Can this be mitigated?
