TOM v. LEN

CONVERSION—withholding deposit for illegitimate reasons

LEN v. TOM

NEGLIGENCE—dropping soda

INTENTIONAL INFLICTION OF EMOTIONAL DISTRESS—shouting in front of tenants, calling Len a crook

SAM v. LEN

NEGLIGENCE—hitting Sam with car

-- CONTRIBUTORY NEGLIGENCE defense regarding Sam not seeing car

WENDY v. LEN

NEGLIGENT INFLICTION OF EMOTIONAL DISTRESS—viewing Sam being hit by Len's car

LEN v. NICK

TRESPASS TO CHATTELS—breaking windshield

SAM v. DOCTOR

NEGLIGENCE—misdiagnosis of Sam's leg
