### **Question One**

Crimes of Tom – Solicitation, Conspiracy, Embezzlement, Grand Theft vs. Petty theft of the chevy with the cocaine, Robbery (when he pulls the car away) Felony murder of Joe, Malicious Mischief for the car mirror.

Crimes of Dick – Conspiracy, Accomplice liability for all of Tom’s crimes, Felony murder of Joe.

Crimes of Harry – Burglary, (use of the instrumentality of the hanger) Grand theft/Larceny/Attempt, Murder down to involuntary, Time to cool, etc., claim of right.

### **Question Two**

Crimes of Bob – Solicitation, Burglary (when he enters Joe’s house to solicit) Murder of Tammy, Merger of Assault on Tammy (Ireland) Arson, felony murder of Linda, conspiracy with Joe.

Crimes of Joe – “It’s a good idea”/aiding and abetting, attempted murder of Linda’s corpse (if she’s already dead), aiding and abetting arson with match/conspiracy, Felony Murder of Linda, accessory after the fact.
