People v. Ted

Larceny of the \$2 (not false pretenses since Bob did not intend to pass [or consent to passage of] possession and title of the additional \$2 to Ted)?

People v. Bob

Malicious mischief of the vending machine?

Assault of Ted? Analyze at both common and modern law. Conclude as to both.

People v. Tammy

Murder of Betty? Define and analyze express and implied malice murder first. Then, define manslaughter and analyze whether mitigated to VM (based on imperfect self-defense/defense of others and/or adequate provocation).
