Defense - defense of others' habitation- or property of another

Assault and battery-when he pulled Trevor down

Homicide- accidental discharge of firearm killing Trevor

Defense of self/ accident not rising to criminal/or Murder/Manslaughter. What theory?

Assault/battery-throwing candy at Zimmer

Defense- self defense

People v. Mary

Assault/Battery- Kicking Zimmer

Intox. defense

Larceny/robbery- Zimmers firearm

Defense- intoxication
