CRIMES OF LUC AND JIM

BURGLARY—Burglary of plane? Could be modern day burglary if wrongful intent, but intent in first entering plane was most likely innocent

LARCENY, LOST/MISLAID PROPERTY or PROPERTY OF DEAD PERSON—Plane appears to have been long buried, but almost certainly could be traced if reported to authorities. Money would belong to plane's owner or pilot's family.

CONSPIRACY?—Not entirely clear whether each was stealing individually or whether they agreed to act in concert as part of a criminal conspiracy. Fact pattern refers to each bag as belonging to a separate individual, but they're acting together.

CRIMES OF JIM

SOLICITATION?—Jim persuading Luc to hide his money. If not conspiracy, then this would be solicitation.

HOMICIDE—Murder? Not really FMR unless there was Burglary of plane. Larceny not an inherently dangerous felony. Maybe 2nd degree FMR modernly or involuntary manslaughter because of conspiracy/solicitation. Jim came up with idea to hide money in tree house (creating danger), then failed to help in a timely manner when Luc fell.

LARCENY, TAKING MONEY FROM DEAD PERSON—Taking money from Luc's pockets. It either belonged to Luc's heirs or pilot's heirs or plane owner.

BURGLARY—entering tree house to steal "Luc's" money could be modern day Burglary if tree house qualifies as a structure. Maybe even C/L Burglary if it qualifies as home of another.

LARCENY—Taking other bag of money from treehouse.
